TERMS AND CONDITIONS

For supply of Equipments

1. The sealed tender shall be submitted, on or before 31 / 01 / 2011 (5 PM), to The Head, Department of Computer Science and Information Technology, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad 431004 INDIA in two separate envelopes.
2. Each of the two envelopes, as mentioned above, shall be superscripted with "QUOTATION FOR EQUIPMENTS". The name of the Contractor/ Supplier with complete address shall be mentioned on the envelopes.
3. The last for submission of the Tender (i.e. 31/ 01 / 2011) must be clearly mentioned on each envelope.
4. In the Envelope No. 1 (should be clearly superscripted on the envelope), the Tenderer should enclose attested copies of –
 - a. Registration/ Shop Act (with update renewal)
 - b. Acknowledgement of the latest Income Tax Return
 - c. Acknowledge of the latest Sales Tax /MVAT /TIN Return
 - d. Authorization certificate of Dealership / Distribution Certificate
 - e. Specification document if any (i.e. Experience in the management of equipments, Portfolio, List of machinery, Technical support staff)
 - f. Detailed Technical brochure of each item.
5. EMD in form of CASH RECEIPT/ DEMAND DRAFT/ BANKER'S CHEQUE.

The Receipt of payment of EMD Rs. 1% (One Percent) of quoted price, if it is paid in cash to the Accounts Section in University, or demand draft/banker's cheque of any Nationalized /Scheduled Bank drawn in the name of The Registrar, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad shall be enclosed with the offer document in the prescribed manner. Offer submitted without the earnest money deposit shall not be considered. EMD will not carry any interest.

6. The Envelope No. 2 (should be clearly superscripted on the envelope) should contain only the FINANCIAL OFFER (i.e. the tender Form duly filled in and signed). The Tenderer should submit their rates strictly in the Tender form Supplied by the University.
7. The rates should be quoted strictly in type written form and shall not be handwritten.
8. The Envelope No. 2 shall be opened only if the EMD and other documents as specified are submitted in Envelope No. 1.
9. The University Authorities shall have the right to decide whether to open or not to open the Envelope No. 2 of any supplier & no objection from any supplier shall be entertained on any grounds whatsoever regarding this.
10. Two separate envelopes (as mentioned above) shall be submitted before the last date and time specified.
11. The rates quoted should be inclusive of all taxes, octroi, freight, transit insurance, Forwarding and other charges. Delivery FOR Department, University Campus and should be inclusive of pre-requisites (if any) for installation and commissioning. The rate should also be quoted for qualification documentation like IQ, PQ, OQ if any.
12. The tenderer is required to execute an agreement on Rs 100/- stamp paper for supply

- of equipment at site.
13. The supplier should provide installation and commissioning of specified scientific equipment in the concerned specialized department at their cost.
 14. The supplier should provide on-site training of operation and routine maintenance of the specified scientific equipment to concerned end users at their cost.
 15. The supplier should supply the equipment of the specification mentioned in the tender form.
 16. The supplier should enclose the list of Govt., Semi Govt., Academic institutions and R & D organizations where the said equipment was supplied earlier.
 17. The successful tenderer is required to deposit an amount of 5% of the tender value as security deposit within a period of 8 days after receiving the firm order. The security deposit won't carry any interest.
 18. If the security deposit is not received within the stipulated period, it will be presumed that the successful tenderer is not interested to supply and the EMD will be forfeited.
 19. The amount of security deposit will be refunded after the guarantee period is over, after submission of the original receipt.
 20. The tenders shall be opened on 01 / 02 / 2011 or on next working day.
 21. For claiming the refund of the EMD, the original receipt of the EMD as well as that of the security deposit must be preserved by the tenderer and should be produced. In case of the EMD / Security Deposit paid by DD / Bankers cheque the Xerox copies of the same must be retained.
 22. The University is registered with the Department of Scientific & Industrial Research (DSIR) for the purpose of availing the custom duty exemption vide Government Notification No. 51/96 Customs dated 23rd July 1996 and Central Excise Duty Exemption vide Government Notification No. 10/97 Central Excise dated 1st March 1997. Hence, the rates should be quoted accordingly.
 23. The Registrar, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad is not bound to accept the lowest tender and reserves right to accept any tender or to reject all the tenders without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
